## ELTHAM PALACE.



**Venue:** Eltham Palace & Gardens, London SE9, by coach from Mill Hill. Once a favoured medieval palace and then a Tudor royal residence, in the 1930s Eltham Palace was transformed by eccentric millionaires Stephen and Virginia Courtauld. It retains the medieval Great Hall of the former royal residence, which has the third-largest hammer-beam roof in England and a quirky Art Deco interior which has been described as a "masterpiece of modern design". There are also 19 acres of award-winning gardens to explore.

**Date:** Tuesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2024.

**Cost:** £35.00 p/p **but current English Heritage and Art Fund members need pay only for the coach and guide elements = £25.**
